

Junction 27 - 30 | M25 Start of Work

Public Information • July 2009

Work to widen the M25 between junctions 27-30 will start on 20 July 2009.

The first phase of work will be between junctions 27-28. A contraflow with three narrow lanes in each direction and temporary 50mph average speed enforcement will be in place to keep everyone safe.

Overnight, when traffic flow is reduced, there will be lane and/or slip road closures as necessary.

Some advance works have already been carried out including:

- surveys and site clearance •
- construction of motorway crossovers •
- construction of our compound and emergency access routes •
- fencing and relocation of newts and reptiles •

We have retained as much of the existing screening as possible, although the M25 will become more visible to some properties for a period. Replanting will take place when the work is complete. All work will be in accordance with the Control of Pollution Act 1974 Section 61.
